

VILLAGE OF MARLBOROUGH
SANITARY LATERAL SEWER PROGRAM

RESIDENT APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to qualify for the program, you must attach a copy of the most current paid cabling bill. If available also provide any history you have on problems with the sewer line.

A sewer problem is considered eligible to receive Village held lateral sewer program funds if after investigation and documentation with a dye test by one licensed plumbing firm in St. Louis County, the lateral sewer line is found to be crushed or collapsed due to causes beyond the control of the property owner. The results of the dye test must accompany this application.

After it is determined that the sewer problem qualifies for the program the homeowner is to solicit three (3) bids from plumbing contractors or drain layers licensed to perform such work in St. Louis County for the necessary repair work to ensure that the bidders have given a fair, competitive bid.

From the three bids received, the homeowner will choose and hire the contractor which the homeowner determines to be the best to repair the sewer service line. The contractor shall obtain all necessary permits from the Village of Marlborough and St. Louis County, perform the work in compliance with the applicable St. Louis County and the Village of Marlborough codes, and submit the itemized bill to the homeowner upon completion of the repair work.

Upon completion of the corrective work, the homeowner will provide the Village of Marlborough the following:

- a. A written statement that the work has been completed.
- b. Copies of the three (3) bids received.
- c. The itemized bill from the contractor.

The village will pay the contractor 100% of the corrective work, not to exceed the lowest responsible bid in accordance with the conditions outlined in the Lateral
